Important Information

2ND SESSION DATES

Monday, July 15 through Friday, August 9

Camp Bmore Kids offers extended day supervision in the morning and afternoon. Additional costs apply and the fee structure can be found on the Camp Add-on's page: www.campbmorekids.com/summer-camp-add-ons. Fees are to be paid directly to the staff on site daily.

MORNING EXTENDED DAY SUPERVISION

Campers may be brought to camp between 7:00 and 9:30 a.m. Our staff will supervise free play during those hours. Campers may be dropped off after 8:30 a.m. for no additional fee.

The morning extended day fee structure is based on the following drop-off windows:

7-7:30 a.m. (\$5), 7:31-8 a.m. (\$3), 8:01-8:30 a.m. (\$2), and 8:31-9:30 a.m. (free)

AFTERNOON EXTENDED DAY SUPERVISION

Campers who will be picked up by 4:10 p.m. will remain on campus for supervised free play. There is no fee for children picked up by 4:10 p.m. Concordia Preparatory School has requested that we are closed by 6 p.m.

The afternoon extended day fee structure is based on the following pick-up windows:

3:30-4:10 p.m. (free) 4:11-4:55 p.m. (\$3) 4:56-5:30 p.m. (\$5) 5:31-6 p.m. (\$10)

Camper Drop-off and Pick-up

Please access the Concordia campus from the main entrance, located off of Concordia Drive, when dropping off and picking up your camper.

MORNING DROP-OFF PROCEDURES

Use the enclosed map to drive to the High School Building.

- Please remain in your car until a staff person greets you and your camper.

AFTERNOON PICK-UP PROCEDURES

Please wait until 3:30 p.m. to enter campus and pick-up your child.

- Remain in your car and display on your dashboard the yellow sign with your child's name on it, which can be found on the back of this booklet.
- If you are delayed and cannot pick-up your child by 6 p.m., please call the afternoon supervisor at 410-686-4920.

General Camp Information

IDENTIFICATION TAGS

Enclosed is your child's ID tag, which should be worn on the first day of camp.

CLOTHING

Campers should wear comfortable, casual clothing that can be worn for a variety of activities, including painting. Appropriate footwear at camp is tennis shoes. Sandals and flip-flops are not permitted. We want to keep our campers' feet safe!

CELL PHONE POLICY

Camp Bmore Kids prohibits the use of electronic communication devices, such as a cell phone, during camp hours. These devices are potential privacy and security threats and will be confiscated if used during the camp day. Campers who need to make a phone call may use the phone in the office.

MISCELLANEOUS

Campers should bring all of their items in a lightweight backpack, which they will keep with them throughout the day. We recommend that each camper bring a water bottle to camp daily. Campers will not be permitted to play with trading cards or use headphones or electronic gaming devices during regular camp hours. These items may be used before and after regular camp hours. We strongly advise campers not to bring valuable games and toys to camp. Camp Bmore Kids is not responsible for any lost items.

Lunch & Activities

LUNCH

Your child is to bring a bag lunch and a beverage to camp each day. Please be sure to pack it in a **gallon zip lock bag** and clearly write his or her name and camp group on it. We have limited refrigeration space. Please comply with this request to ensure that each lunch is properly refrigerated. Good News — Gallon Bags can be reused!

ELECTIVES

Campers who have completed kindergarten and above will choose from our schedule of electives on the first day of the session.

SWIM PROGRAM

Our swim program consists of swim instruction followed by a free swim each day (weather permitting). Camp Bmore Kids will have exclusive use of the swimming pool at Hillcrest Swim Club during the morning hours. Campers should bring a bathing suit and towel clearly marked with their name every day. We encourage our campers to use spray suntan lotion.
